Mayor Simon says that Portland is to have an emergency hospital, that is, if the city council carries out his wishes. The mayor proposes to utilize a wing of the proposed new city jail to be built at Park and Everett streets for the purpose. He thinks an institution of this kind can be provided for at a small addition to the appropriation that will be necessary for the construction of the jail building.
