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## VOTE TO BANISH SALOONS, NOV. 2

Whitman County Organizes  
Campaign for Special Local  
Option Election.

Pullman, Wash., July 31.—The first election in Whitman county under the new local option law will be held November 2. Every precinct in the county will vote on the question, if sufficient voters sign the petitions asking that an election be held.

A rousing meeting of the temperance people of Whitman county held at Garfield has launched the campaign to be opened next week when petitions will be circulated in the 46 precincts of Whitman county. There will be 14 different "units," as each of the 13 incorporated towns forms a separate "unit" and all of the territory not in the incorporated towns makes a unit.

All of the larger towns of the county and many of the country precincts were represented at the mass meeting. A committee of 15 was appointed to arrange a campaign and this committee appointed a subcommittee of three with full authority to manage the campaign. The three men selected are Rev. M. H. Marvin of Pullman, pastor of the Methodist church; F. J. Wilmer of Rosalia, a prominent banker, hardware merchant and grain dealer; and Honorable R. J. McCroskey, ex-state senator, of Garfield, a wealthy farmer, merchant and banker.

The grange and the Farmers' Educational and Cooperative union, two powerful farmers' organizations, have declared repeatedly for local option.

**New Parcels Post Agreements.**

Washington, July 31.—Beginning tomorrow, the parcels post arrangement recently concluded by the United States with Denmark and Japan will become effective. Parcels for those countries will be accepted up to \$50 in value and 11 pounds in weight. This arrangement is in accordance with the postoffice department's plan to extend the usefulness of the parcels post to foreign countries. The 11 pound weight limit now applies to all countries except France and Sweden, the weight for those countries being four pounds and six ounces. The limit of value, however, is not uniform as to all countries.

**Historical Pageant at Duxbury.**

Duxbury, Mass., July 31.—Duxbury held high carnival today in celebration of the landing of the Pilgrims at Plymouth, and the coming of Miles Standish, John Alden and other Pilgrims to Duxbury, and in honor of their courage, heroism and valor. The program included the dedication of the Miles Standish monument, an address by Honorable John B. Long, and a series of historical pageants depicting events in the history of the Pilgrims in England, Holland and America.

## COMBINE FORCES IN RATE FIGHT

Walla Walla Will Assist  
Spokane to Secure Terminal Rates.

Walla Walla, Wash., July 31.—Announcement has just been made that Walla Walla will aid Spokane in her fight for inland terminal rates. Salt Lake and Ogden have taken up the fight in their own behalf, but Walla Walla is the first aid Spokane in this.

Papers have been filed in Washington, D. C. in a suit in intervention before the Interstate Commerce commission, as it is a case of aiding Spokane, both are working together for the interests of each. The case was prepared and the papers forwarded by Attorney H. M. Stevens of Spokane.

The transportation committee of the Commercial club is behind the move. They have already raised over \$1,000 for the fight and more has been promised if it is necessary. Harry B. Strong is chairman of the committee. The other members are Oscar Drumheller, John Smith, Fred Clarke and N. D. Hopkinson.

Wholesalers and other large shippers of this vicinity have long chafed under the rate charged by the transcontinental railroads, and are determined to stay with Spokane in the fight until the case is either won or hopelessly lost.

**STEAMER HITS SUBMERGED ROCK**

Feared That Schooner Winnebago Is a Total Loss  
With Crew of 15 Men.

San Francisco, July 31.—The steam schooner Winnebago, with Captain Turner and a crew of 15 men aboard, struck a submerged rock off the coast of San Francisco today, and it is feared she is a total loss.

Details of the accident are lacking. Major reports have been received here by the Coast Steamship company, owners of the vessel, but they fail to state whether the vessel was damaged or not. The captain and crew were rescued.

The Winnebago was loaded with lumber, which was carrying from Everett, Wash., to San Pedro, Cal., and this fact leads to the hope that she is still afloat.

Two relief ships were sent to the scene of the wreck by the Coast Steamship company as soon as news of the accident was received.
