

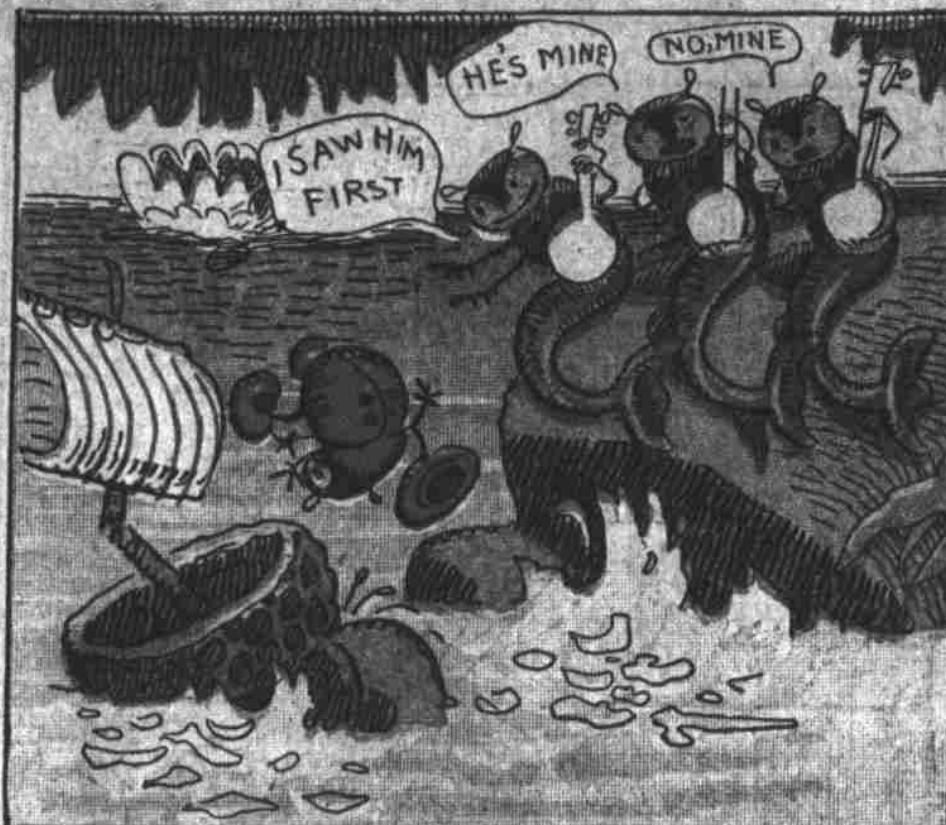
# THE TALE OF THE BUGVILLE LORELEI.



1. The Lorelei! What a beautiful legend of old! How beautiful those sirens must have been as they sat on a rock crooning their enchanting melodies!



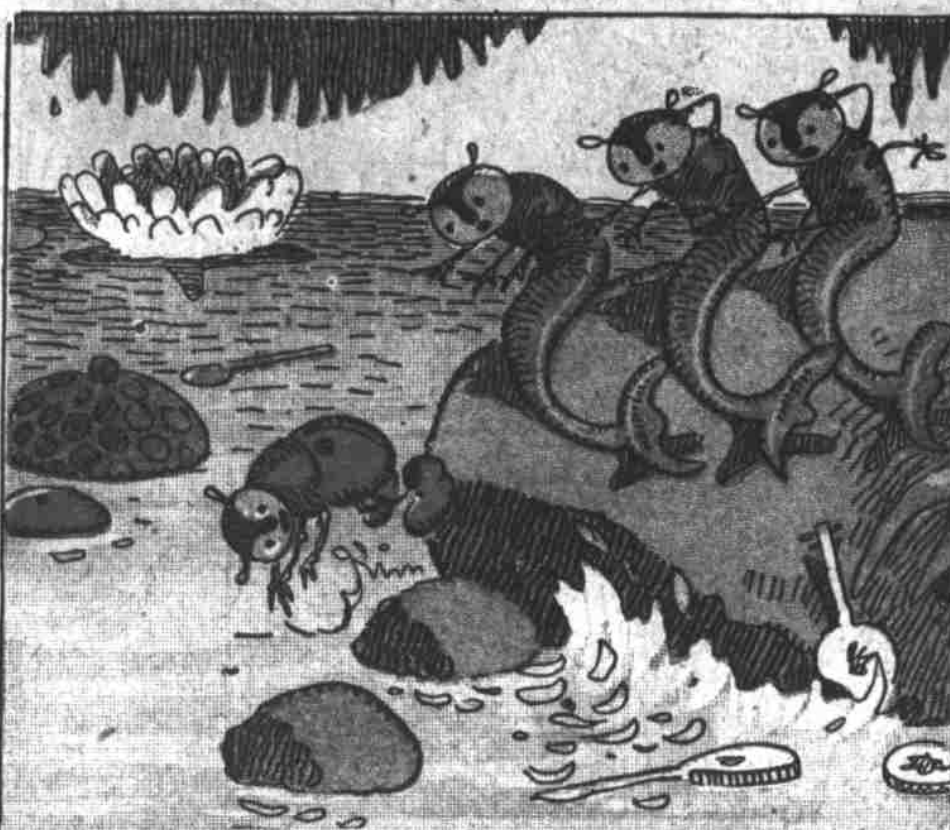
2. And the poor sailor! How ravished were his ears by that intoxicating harmony! He listened enraptured! And his craft drifted toward the cruel rocks!

1. BOYS—Let's put in some more hot water and give little brother a hot surprise while Gran'pa goes for the towels!



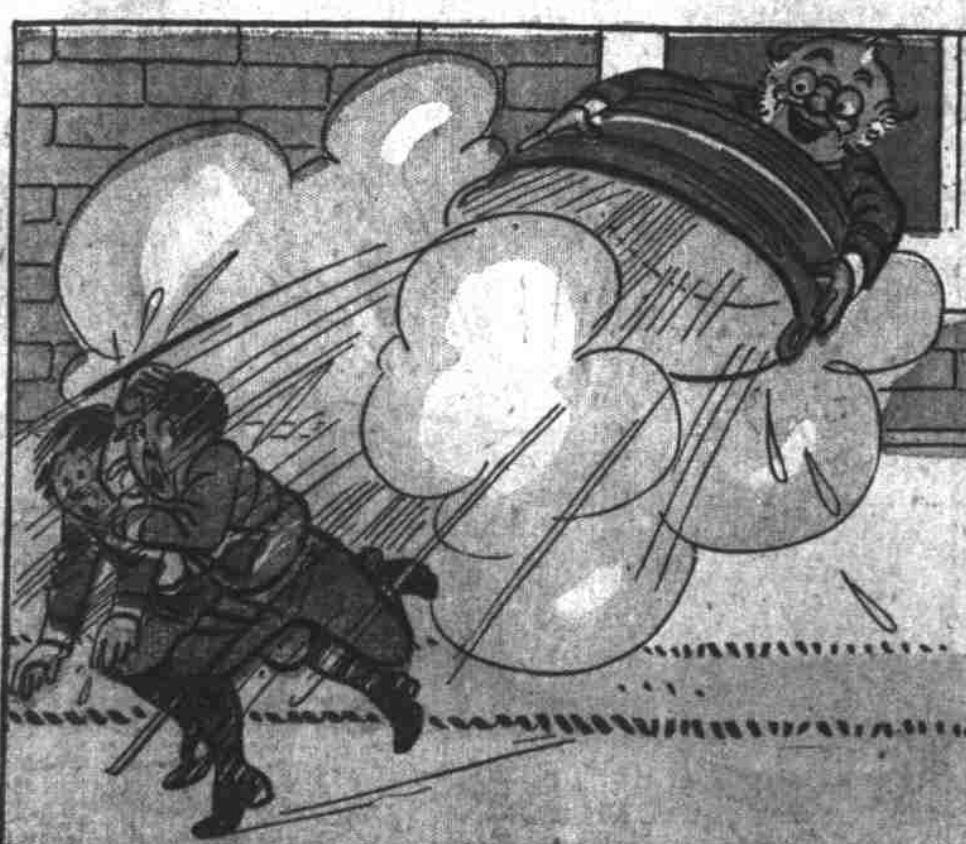
2. BOYS—Hoop-la! Now in you go, little brother!



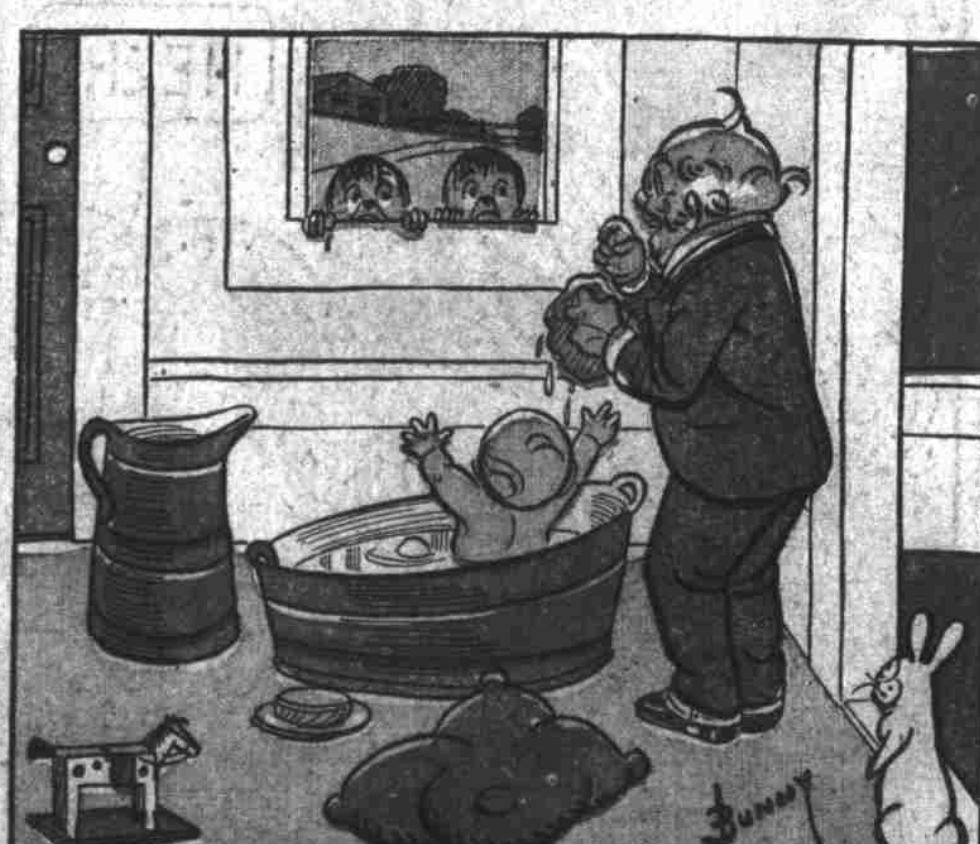
3. BOYS—Skip! Here comes Gran'pa!
