Salmon Catches Decrease as Water Reaches Low Stage—Season's Pack Good. Convention Begins Here Tuesday to Last Four Days.

The Dalles, Or., Aug. 14.—The waters of the Columbia have fallen to a stage that fish wheels are now making very light catches of salmon. No heavy catches are expected between now and August 25, when fishing will shut down until September 10, in accordance with the new fish law.
