## News of the Day in Brief

London, Aug. 27.—R. L. Borden, opposition leader in the dominion house of commons, sailed for home today after a two months' vacation in Europe.

New York, Aug. 27.—The national committee of the United Irish League of America met at the Hoffman house today to discuss matters of importance in connection with the present work for the Irish government.

Oshkosh, Wis., Aug. 27.—The German Press association of Wisconsin began its annual meeting here today with a good attendance. The proceedings will continue over Saturday and Sunday.

San Francisco, Cal., Aug. 27.—Archbishop Riordan celebrated his sixty-seventh birthday today, having been born in New Brunswick, August 27, 1847. In December he will complete his twenty-fifth year as archbishop of San Francisco.

Fort Worth, Texas, Aug. 27.—The Texas State Stenographers association is holding its annual convention in Fort Worth. President Claude McCaleb presided at the opening session this morning. The convention will last two days.

Asbury Park, N. J., Aug. 27.—This famous resort is crowded with visitors for the annual carnival, which was ushered in today with the Queen's coronation. The festivities will come to an end next Thursday with the baby parade.

Delafield, Wis., Aug. 27.—A wedding of note here today was that of Miss Alice Smythe, sister of the Rev. Sidney T. Smythe, president of St. John's Military academy, and Frank William Mouse of Beltspring, Wash., dean of the department of mathematics at the academy.

Buffalo, N. Y., Aug. 27.—More than 20 states are represented at the convention of the National Association of Attorneys-General which assembled here today for a two days' session. An address by Governor Hughes on the "Enforcement of State Laws" is to be the chief feature of the program.

Xenia, Ohio, Aug. 27.—The Reformed Presbyterian church at Cedarville, where Whitelaw Reid, ambassador to the court of St. James, worshipped as a boy and young man, began today a celebration of the one hundredth anniversary of its foundation. The celebration will cover a period of three days.

St. Paul, Minn., Aug. 27.—All arrangements have been concluded for the reception and entertainment of the delegates to the annual convention of the National Association of Letter Carriers, which meets here Monday. The convention promises to be one of more than ordinary importance. Among other things it will petition the government to establish a system for pensioning letter carriers who have been in the service for a specified number of years.

Pawtucket, R. I., Aug. 27.—To celebrate the one hundredth anniversary of the birth of William Jeffers, who brought fame to this city as the builder of the old hand fire engine, a big muster of the "red shirts" of New England was held here today under the auspices of the Pawtucket veterans firemen's association. Jeffers was one of the most noted builders of fire tubs in his time. During his career he built and put in commission more than 150 hand fire engines, which were distributed throughout the country, and many of which are yet in use by veteran firemen's associations.
