## DUE TO HIGH COST OF FEED

Creameries Advance Milk Prices—Better Quality Is the Cause.

Prices of milk sold from creameries have been raised, the advance taking effect today. Farmers supplying milk creamery operators say, demand more money for their product because of the sudden high cost of feed. Milk by the quart, formerly costing \$1.50 a month will now cost \$1.85. Milk by quart has been similarly raised from \$1.50 to \$1.75 a month.
