San Francisco did all her scoring in the first and fourth innings. In the opening canto, Mohler was safe on Johnson's error, a bunt throw that allowed the kid to take second. Miller drove him home and when Fisher threw the ball back to second to head Miller, neither Cooney nor Olson was on the bag and the ball went into the field, Mr. Morrell.

Johnson came in in the second inning on his single, a walk and Spears' terrific rap into the outfield. By the way Spears captured three hits in three times at bat, leading the day's batting.

The home side made four in the fourth and the invaders copped the same number in the sixth. It was in the ninth that the northerners tied up the score and sent the game into extra sessions. Spears singled and Guyn sacrificed him to second. Olson grounded to Bender and made an effort to keep Spears from reaching third.
