AT CAIRO

WOMEN in Cairo, Ill., are carrying revolvers. It is the fruit of inter-race hatred. One dead, one dying and several wounded is the outcome of a clash between whites and blacks a few days ago. Troops are on guard and feudism so intense as to be at the breaking point.

It is but three months ago that the same city was the scene of a similar outbreak of the mob spirit. Violence at that time claimed a number of victims, and kept the city in a wild storm of passion for several days. Subsequent attempts to apprehend and punish the ringleaders were futile, a fact that in part doubtless explains the latest outbreak.

PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXATION

MAJOR GAYNOR, Andrew Carnegie and other prominent men of New York have lately been discussing the subject of personal property taxation, and the conclusion reached by most of them, as it has been reached by many students of the matter heretofore, is that the attempted taxation of personal property, especially money, notes, accounts, stocks and bonds, is to a great extent a failure.

Only a small portion of such property is reached, that of the moribund or least conscientious possessors escapes; this sort of taxation invites evasion and disregard of law, and successful perjury; it leads to flagrant injustice and discrimination, often against widows and orphans; it penalizes honesty and in effect rewards dishonesty.

FUDGE PIE

ONE egg, one cup sugar, one piece of butter size of an egg. Cream well together and add one cup of milk and enough flour to make it right consistency for cake and two teaspoons of baking powder or dry yeast. Bake in greased muffin pie plates. Filling for pie—Three cups of light brown sugar and a small piece of butter. Roll for eight minutes, stirring constantly. Then remove from the fire and beat until creamy. Add the well-sifted flour, one cup of two cups of spoon of vanilla. Let pie stand until cold. This filling is to be used for frosting the upper part of pie also. This is very delicious.

AMBER MARMALADE

AMBER MARMALADE—One large orange, one lemon, one grape fruit, one cup of sugar, one cup of water and cores. Measure fruit and add three times the quantity of water. Let stand overnight, then boil five minutes, add pint for pint of sugar and let stand till next day. Boil gently for about two hours, or till the jelly is about as thick as apple sauce. This will make 12 glasses, and is delicious.

SCALLOPED CRANBERRIES

SCALLOPED CRANBERRIES—Moisten two cups bread crumbs with half a cup of butter. Butter a pudding dish, sprinkle in a layer of the crumbs, add a layer of stewed and sweetened cranberries, 12 large seeded raisins and a little grated lemon rind, continue the layers until the crumbs are used; cover and bake half an hour in a moderate oven. Serve hot with hard sauce.
