Des Moines, Ia., May 17.—Sleep came for the first time in two months to Miss Esther Chinberg of Odabolt, Ia., a student at Simpson college, Thursday night. Starting 60 days ago to cram for her final examinations, Miss Chinberg began drinking black coffee and taking other steps to keep herself awake until she found she had contracted a case of insomnia that outstrips anything in the history of medical science in the Middle West.
