

OPEN RIVER ASSN. MEETS AT EUGENE

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.)
Eugene, Or., May 16.—The Open River association met at Eugene this afternoon. The 50 or more delegates were received at the station by a large

number of citizens in automobiles and taken for a scenic trip about the city and to the University of Oregon. Eugene is at her prettiest at this season of the year. The huge maple trees which line the streets in the older part of the city are magnificent in their dark green foliage and from Skinner's butte the city at the foot of the hill presents the spectacle of a veritable forest.

At the Commercial club parlors the addresses of welcome were made by Mayor J. D. Matlock. At 8:30 o'clock the citizens of the city will give the delegates a dinner at the new Osburn \$110,000 hotel. At 8 o'clock the business session of the convention will be

held at the court house. W. A. Williams of Portland will be the principal speaker, his topic being the benefits to be derived by Eugene through an open river.

The Commercial club and citizens have cooperated to make this the best convention in the short history of the association. All of the stores are decorated and the business streets are draped in flags.
