

IDEA IS TO RELIEVE CONGESTION BY BREAKING AND MAKING UP TRAINS BETWEEN TACOMA AND SEATTLE.

Foreseeing a tremendous congestion of traffic as a result of rapid development of the Pacific northwest, the Northern Pacific railway has already taken steps to prevent it.

The move believed capable of solving the problem that has been confronting the northern line for some time is the establishment of a large terminal with sufficient room for the breaking up of westbound freight trains and making up of eastbound trains.

The site selected for this terminal is at Auburn, a small station about midway between Tacoma and Seattle, where the Northern Pacific from Pasco connects with the line from Portland to Seattle by way of Tacoma.

The Y shaped intersection, it is expected, will remain, but the terminal and tracks will run north and south over a large area of ground.

SMUGGLER LOSES HIS CITIZENSHIP

(United Press Leased Wire.) New York, May 21.—Ex-Governor Frank West Rollins, of New Hampshire, was shown of his citizenship when he pleaded guilty yesterday to the charge of attempting to defraud the government of customs duties, according to a statement by District Attorney Wise.

Rollins was indicted by the federal grand jury for failing to inform the New York customs officers that he brought clothing and other articles from Europe valued at \$4750. He appeared in the United States circuit court yesterday and pleaded guilty to the charge. Judge Hand fined him \$2000, which he promptly paid.

LONGSHOREMAN KILLED FOR MONEY

San Diego, Cal., May 21.—That Charles Weddeman, a Swedish longshoreman, who came here from San Francisco recently was murdered for his money and thrown into the bay, was the verdict of the coroner's jury. The two bullet holes in the man's skull caused the verdict of murder. When Weddeman disappeared three weeks ago he told his friends that he was saving his money and the police are convinced that he was murdered for his savings, only 5 cents being found in his pockets when he was taken from the water.

MAKES PROMISES FOR THEIR CHIEF

Saying He Will Reply on Senate Floor to Charge of Bribery in Illinois Legislature in Connection With His Election.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Chicago, May 21.—Senator William Lorimer will start for Washington late today and his friends say he will reply, from the floor of the senate, to the charges of bribery in connection with his election.

Lorimer has refused to state definitely whether he will make such a reply or not and his refusal also to discuss the report that a congressional inquiry will be demanded.

The fact that Lorimer will reach Washington and appear in the senate on the day that the trial of O'Neill Browne, indicted for bribery in connection with the senator's election, begins has caused considerable comment in political circles. It is believed that the senator's appearance in Washington on that day will make it necessary for him to take some stand in his own defense.
