

STORM ON WAY TO THE COLUMBIA

Norwegian Steamer Titania Arrives From Antwerp With 2000 Tons General Freight; May Go to Japanese Port.

After having made the run from Antwerp to San Francisco under ideal conditions, the Norwegian steamer Titania encountered fearful weather on her last lap of the voyage to Portland, and arrived here this morning 24 hours over-

Captain Krueger and the officers of the big steamer say that seldom have they in all their experience encountered such nasty weather in summer as that into which the steamer poked her nose coming here from San Francisco. Tremendous seas broke over the high bow almost incessantly for three days, and then on the fourth the heavy sea was augmented by dense fog, making navigation extremely dangerous. Under these conditions it was necessary to proceed under slow ball a good part of the way.

The Titania docked at the North Bank wharf this morning and will begin discharging 2000 tons of general freight tomorrow or possibly late this afternoon when the steamer will probably proceed to Japan, although she is not reported as being under charter for outward cargo.

SEVERAL COASTERS ARRIVE

Bring Freight and Passengers From Oregon and California. Several coasters arriving in the harbor this morning bringing freight and passengers. The steamer Newport came in from Bandon this morning and the S. Loop brought a considerable quantity of freight from San Francisco. The Loop will take lumber for a return cargo.

ALONG THE WATERFRONT

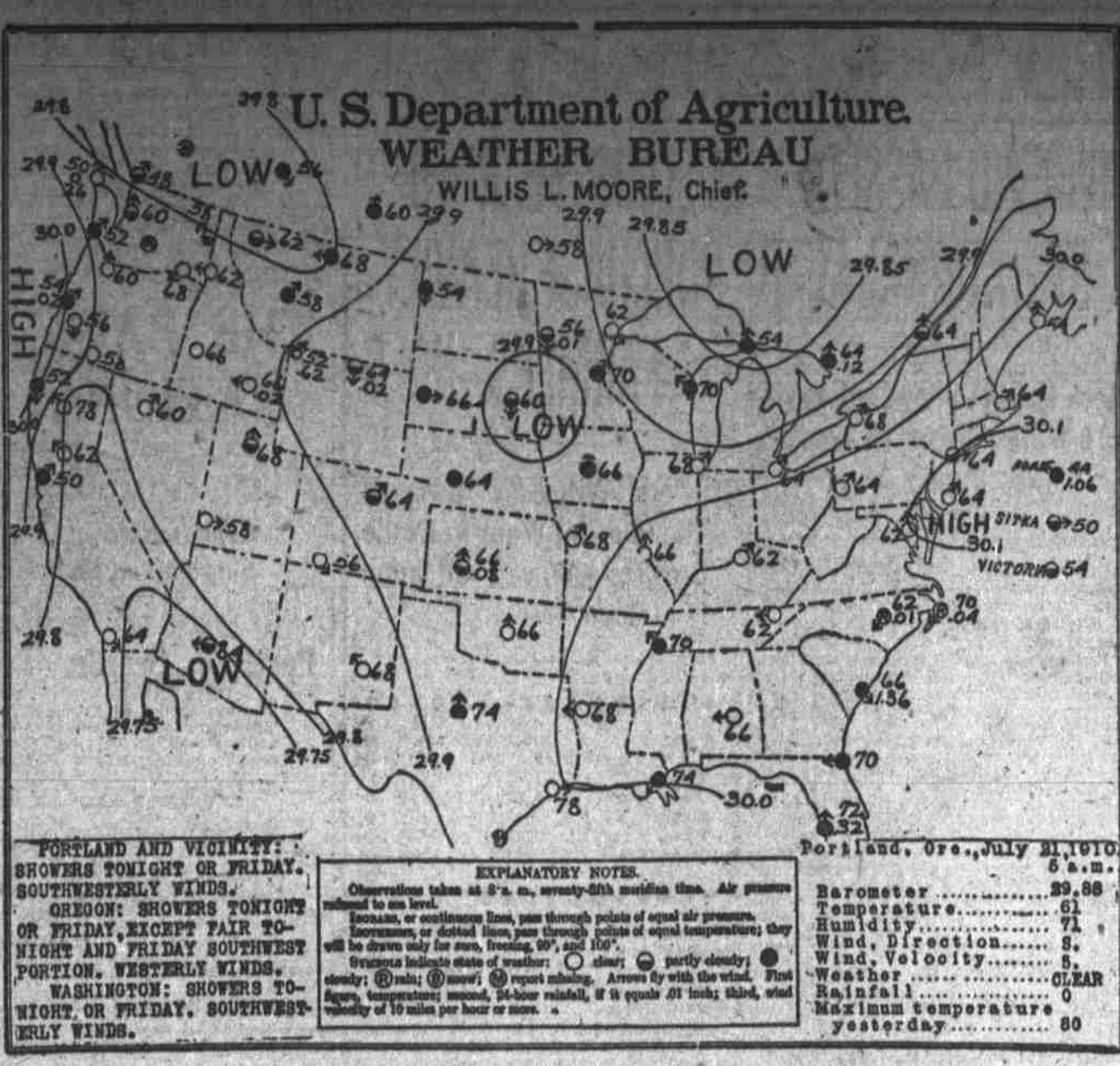
