

NEW SWIMMING POOL FOR SOUTH PORTLAND

After a visit of the park board and the mayor yesterday afternoon to the new swimming pool at Sellwood park, they decided another one should be built in South Portland early next year. The new Sellwood pool has proven so popular in filling a want long needed that the park board will be very liberal in the way of swimming pools.

Instead of the boys using the river, they will be given nice cement tanks, where they will have a sand pile, lockers and complete gymnasium. In this kind of attraction, the city hopes to be

able to attract the boys along useful lines. South Portland people have been after Superintendent Michels and the park board to build them a pool, and the opinion of the board is that it shall be done. The peninsula people also want a pool. They will be taken care of as soon as possible.

PUSH CLUB DELEGATES READY FOR BIG MEET

A convention of delegates from the improvement clubs of this city will be held at 8 o'clock tomorrow evening at the office suite of John H. Hook, third floor of Lumbermens building, Fifth

and Stark streets. This meeting is called by resolution of a convention held August 11, at which 22 clubs were represented, for the purpose of completing the permanent organization of a body of delegates from all the clubs to discuss and act upon matters of common interest.

A com-

mittee will present a set of rules for the government of the club and for the conduct of the meetings. It is common knowledge that the rules of order are a large factor in the future success or failure of the organization, and it is expected that they will be carefully and thoroughly considered. Some unfinished business relating to school matters will come up. The members of the school board have been invited to attend. If time permits some new matters may be presented.
