hext week will entirely clean up this variety. Grapes-295 cars. Movement of this variety this week is pretty nearly 100 cars heavier than for last week. To-kays are now going forward in very small volume and the bulk of the ship-ment is composed of Cornichens and Emperors. From the best information obtainable the total movement from now on can hardly be expected to aggre-gate more than 250 outs at the outside. Weather conditions continue favorable and should there be no further rain it is expected that the crop-will be prac-tically cleaned up within the next ten days.
