

HAVANA-KEY WEST FLIGHT PROPOSED

Moissant Hopes to Interest President Gomez in Aviation Meet in Cuba.

(Dates From Leased Wire.)
Havana, Nov. 21.—A flight from Havana to Key West in an aeroplane is the latest thriller to be contemplated by aviators. An offer to fly over that route was made today by John B. Moissant to President Gomez of Cuba. Moissant is seeking the aid of Gomez in promoting a two weeks' aviation meet in the island, and would terminate it with the Havana-Key West flight.

The attempt is considered one of the most hazardous ever proposed. Practically the entire flight would be over water. This might not seem so bad, were it not for the knowledge that a man might be torn to pieces within a few minutes after he struck the water, by man-eating sharks that infest these seas.

Sudden squalls are of common occurrence in this gulf region, making air flights doubly hazardous.
