

**TITLE TO TIMBER CLAIMS CLEARED**

Government Fails to Prove Valuable Land Secured by Fraud.

Title to eight timber claims in Linn county valued at possibly \$50,000 has been made perfect so far as C. A. Smith, Frederick Krebs and others are concerned, through the dismissal in United States court of the government's suit to cancel the titles to the land, under claim they had been fraudulently secured.

This suit was one of three brought against Smith, Krebs and their associates by the government to cancel title to Linn county timber land. The two other suits involved land value at between \$500,000 and \$700,000. United States District Attorney McCourt announced when the two other cases were tried that he would dismiss the third suit. He secured permission from the attorney general and Judge Wolverton dismissed it Monday.

"We did not have enough evidence to try the case and win on it," said Mr. McCourt. "The eight claims involved in the suit had been secured some two years after the 47 claims involved in the other two, and after the men who secured them had found safer and more ingenious ways of getting land than was practiced during the earlier and fraud days. We found after three months' careful investigation, that we could only show three fraudulent filings. We had nothing at all to show that the owners had purchased the land knowing it was secured fraudulently and without that proof I knew I could not hope to secure a cancellation of the claims."

**2 FEET OF SNOW AT SUMPTER; MORE FALLING**

Sumpter, Or., Nov. 30.—Deep snow and a severe winter is what the weather prophets see for the winter of 1910-11.
