

SUGAR-REFINING
FACE CHARGES

(United Press Special Wire.)
Washington, Dec. 13.—The statute of limitations does not operate to protect Gustave Kiesel and Theodore Harned, alleged conspirators, in circumstances resulting in the closing of the Pennsylvania Sugar refinery, the bankruptcy of Adolph Sigmund and the suicide of Frank Hippel, according to the supreme court, which yesterday ruled that the man should be tried.

The decision was rendered on an appeal from a decision of Judge Holt of the federal court in New York, who ruled that the indictments against Kiesel and Harned on the ground that the offense was completed before January 5, 1910, when the statute of limitations became operative in their case.

Indictments against nearly all of the directors of the sugar trust growing out of the same case are now pending. General Counsel Parsons is one of the men indicted. The ruling in the case means that the cases will be brought to trial in the district court.
