

MAKES ALL STOCK SUBJECT TO BOARD

Bill Regulating Disease Tests Agreed on by General Committee.

The proposed creation of a state livestock sanitary board by the present legislature was approved by a general committee of woolgrowers, dairymen, livestock breeders, the state board of health and the Consumers' league, at a meeting yesterday afternoon in the Medical building.

The most important feature of the bill is its provision for a compulsory state wide tuberculosis test for dairy cows. It gives to the state veterinarian or his deputies power to go to any dairy and make the test.

The bill also proposes to legislate against all kinds of animal diseases. Contagious, infectious or communicable diseases found in any domestic animal must be reported.

GENERAL DUVAL ON RETIRED LIST

From West Point in 1869; Distinguished Service; Incidental Changes.

Washington, Jan. 12.—Some important changes among the general officers of high rank in the army went into effect today as a result of the retirement of Major General William P. Duvall, who has been in command of the division of the Philippines since the beginning of 1909.

Major General Duvall leaves behind him an enviable record for efficient and faithful service. General Duvall is a native of Maryland and a graduate of the West Point academy of the class of 1869.

artillery. When the war with Spain began, he was selected as major inspector general of volunteers. In 1898, after having been lieutenant colonel, he was honorably discharged from the volunteer service. He was mustered out of the service in 1901 with the rank of colonel.

colonel. In March of the same year he was made brigadier general. This rank he held until October 2, 1907, when he became major general. A year later he was selected to succeed Major General John F. Weston in command of the troops in the Philippines.

eral J. Franklin Bell, former chief of staff, today took over the command of the army of the Philippines, relieving Brigadier General Pershing, who has been in temporary charge since the departure of Major General Duvall.
