The measures that looked towards progress.

Let Splendid One.

"The list of victories is a splendid one. It is no longer and no shorter than I anticipated; and yet, had we won only the initiative, referendum and advisory referendum, would have been abundantly worth while."

"With these measures in the form of constitutional amendments to be submitted to the people, the voters were supplied with the means of taking the power of government into their own hands by the direct exercise of the right of making laws, selecting them and of controlling their public officials."

"As I say, there has been stubborn opposition to what we know to be the will of the people as expressed at the polls and in the matter of legislation. This important duty remains—to inform the people how their representatives served them."

"I am going to make this my personal duty. Within a few weeks I shall undertake to call the roll of the legislature throughout the state. I shall go into every district and tell the people as plainly, as frankly and as fairly as I can how those men whom they sent to represent them, served them. The people have the right to know this and it is important that they be informed. I shall see to it personally that they are informed accurately. That it will word towards the good of the state is certain. At all events, the people will be in a position to vote with a full knowledge of the facts."

The session was marked by the passage of a score of important measures, and a host of smaller ones in the interests of cleaner politics, the betterment of labor conditions and the reformation of judicial procedure.

Resolved to submit to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment granting suffrage to women.

Full train crew bill, penalizing railroads for failure to carry full crews on all trains.

Resolution to election laws providing for a return to the Australian ballot system by abolishing the party circle. The election of judges and of the state superintendent of public instruction is made non-partisan by the provision that candidates for those offices have no political designation on the ballot.

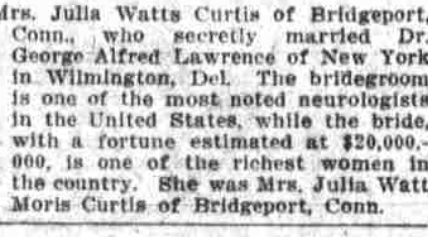
Bill limiting the labor of women to eight hours per day and 48 hours per week, except in the perishable fruit industry. Violation of this law is made a misdemeanor, punishable by fine or imprisonment.

Some of the progressive legislation passed by the session which closed today follows:

Resolution to submit to the people a constitutional amendment providing for the initiative and referendum. Under this proposed amendment petitioners for an initiative and referendum election must number not less than 8 per cent of all the votes of all candidates for governor at the last general state election.

Resolution to submit to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment providing for the recall of all elective officers, including the judiciary. Petitioners for a recall election must number not less than 13 per cent of the votes cast for all candidates for governor at the last state election.



Hints for Sewing Room

Sewing machine needles may be used much longer if, when the points begin to get dull, they are rubbed on a piece of emery board.

As good as a patent ripper is a steel crocheted book which will catch under threads, pull out bastings, etc., in double quick time.

When filling window boxes one is confronted with the necessity of selecting flowers that are not only effective, but constant bloomers from the beginning to the end of the season.
