

NORTH STAR, FROM ASTORIA, WILL GO VIA HOWES WRECK

Will Land Underwriter Man and Diver, Who Will See Whether Columbia Packers Get Any Tins.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Seattle, April 21.—For the purpose of conducting a survey on the wooden cannery ship *Jabez Howes*, which was beached at Chignik, Alaska, April 6, after she had begun to leak so fast that this course was necessary to save her, Captain E. C. Genereux of the Seattle office of the San Francisco Board of Marine Underwriters, will leave for Chignik tomorrow. He will go north on the Columbia River Packers' association's tug *North Star*, which is bound for that company's cannery at Nushagak but will detour to Chignik. Accompanying the Captain Genereux will be Captain Finch, a local diver, who will take his gear for making a thorough examination of the *Howes* below water. The two men will join the *North Star* at Astoria.

Advices from Chignik are extremely meagre but it is understood that the *Howes* is in a serious plight and will likely be a total loss. She arrived at Chignik with the ship *Star of Alaska* from San Francisco and Benjamin F. Packard from Puget Sound, after they had anchored, a terrific gale blew them ashore. The vessels floated themselves but the *Howes* opened her seams and began to leak so fast that she had to be beached. There is no wire to Chignik and it was necessary to dispatch a launch 400 miles to the east in order to send out word from Seward. Steamers call at Chignik but once a month.

It is surmised from the brief reports that the *Howes* was beached broadside. The message stated that she was lying on a sloping shore and it is thought likely she has slid down and is nearly wholly submerged. The ship, it is understood, is not insured, although valued at between \$15,000 and \$20,000. The cargo is valued, including tin, acids, boxes, food supplies, pling and other necessities of a large cannery. If the surveyors decide there is a chance of salvage, they will send word out to Seward and from that port orders will be called for a salvage steamer to proceed to the scene of the wreck.

The wreck is a severe loss to the cannery company owning the *Howes*. Should the cargo be partly saved, it is possible the cannery can be operated at part capacity. If all the cargo is lost, the company will lose its entire season's

pack. Should all the cargo but the tin be saved, it will be impossible to do any cannery as there is no supply of tin on this coast. It is estimated that the cargo is valued at close to \$100,000, much of the insurance being carried by the Firemen's Fund Insurance company of San Francisco.

Captain Genereux is anticipating a long stay away. The *North Star* will proceed by the outside route and under ordinary circumstances ought to make Chignik in about eight days. The surveyors are being sent out by the board which, as is customary, is trying to save its members all the loss possible.
