

TEMPORARY HOUSE FOR GYPSY SMITH MAY BE ERECTED

Question of Handling Great Crowds Who Will Come to Hear Evangelist Is Serious Problem to Solve.

The Gypsy Smith committee is having troubles of its own. The famous evangelist is coming to Portland next November. Audiences attracted to hear him will be of course greater than any local structure can house, it is predicted.

The first plan was to build a temporary auditorium seating six to eight thousand people. The expense estimates made it apparent that the cost of the great meetings might be burdened. One of the old buildings on the Lewis & Clark fair grounds was considered, but the longer it is considered the less it grows in favor.

"If the greatest living evangelist, brought to Portland for the greatest series of religious meetings in the city's history, were to be held in a shabby fair ground structure, some of the committee have argued, it would, as a consequence, appear that we did not consider it worth while to make adequate preparations, then the people would say it was not worth while to come and by their presence and interest make the meeting a success."

The Young Men's Christian Association announces for tomorrow afternoon the first of three highly important meetings for men. The meeting will be held at 3 p. m. in the Helix theatre. President William Truitt Foster is the speaker of the day.

"I believe this will be one of the most valuable meetings we have ever held," said Richard R. Perkins, religious work director of the Y. M. C. A. "The next two Sunday afternoon meetings will also be held in the Helix theatre, and at each of them we expect great audiences of men."

A mass meeting for men will be held tomorrow evening in the Highland Baptist church. It is for the purpose of calling to the attention of men their duty and opportunity in connection with church work. What men may do for their country is the subject of the evening.

The "Tale of the Big Trees" is to be the subject of Dr. Benjamin Young's sermon at Taylor Street Methodist church next Sunday morning. Dr. Young has just returned from attendance at the industrial peace conference in San Francisco.

AUDITORIUM BONDS ISSUE IS ENDORSED

First of east side organizations to endorse the public auditorium bond issue is the North East Side Improvement association which passed unanimous resolutions of approval at a well attended meeting last night.

R. W. Raymond, manager of the Commercial club convention bureau, appeared before the association and stated that the bond issue of \$600,000 will meet the expense of site and construction of the public auditorium. No other city which possesses a public auditorium, he said, has ever found it a "white elephant," but always a profitable investment, paying actual cash returns on the cost.

The association appointed a committee consisting of H. A. Heppner, E. Versteeg, W. C. North, F. S. Myers, L. Peery, D. H. Foley and C. S. Shannett to ascertain the position of candidates for public office toward the Broadway bridge. The plan of purchasing 20 acres near Killingsworth avenue and East Sixteenth street was endorsed.
