MITCHELL, FUGITIVE, DIES IN HONDURAS

(United Press Leased Wire.)
San Francisco, June 12.—Friends learned today of the death Sunday in Honduras of R. Brent Mitchell, 60, former prosperous lawyer and broker of San Francisco. Since his flight the day before Christmas, 1905. leaving liabilities aggregating \$200,000. Mitchell made several unsuccessful attempts to retrieve his fortunes with the hope of returning to San Francisco. He worked indefatigably for five years in Central America, promoting the devel-opment of railroads, mines and coffee and rubber plantations. The deaths of his wife and daughter are believed to have hastened his end.


