# Pioneer Week--A Tribute to Oregon's Old Settlers!



**THIS** is the week all Oregon pays tribute to the men and women who crossed the plains three score years ago—who suffered the hardships of early days, fought the Indians, paved the way for the great, progressive land of plenty which we know today!

Many of the old settlers—still our patrons—were acquainted with Aaron Meier, the founder of this business, and will remember the little store on Front street, where The Meier & Frank Company had its beginning in 1857. The Oregon Pioneer association is holding its 39th annual reunion this week, and Wednesday, June 21, will be Pioneer Day. We cordially invite all our old friends to visit the store this week. We shall be delighted to conduct you through the store and point out the wonderful steps which have been made in storekeeping methods since 1857.

## Articles Loaned Us by Oregon Historical Society on Exhibition 5th. St. Window

- 1—**CHAIR**, made for Gen. Philip H. Sheridan in 1858 and used by him at Fort Yamhill when he served there in 1857-61, as a second lieutenant in the United States army.
- 2—**COFFEE MILL**, once the property of Gen. Sheridan.
- 3—**EASY CHAIR**, made in the Coast Range about 60 miles west of Portland, in 1860. An antidote for the bac-ka-che.
- 4—**BOOKING CRAB**, made in Portland in 1853-54 by John B. Garrison.
- 5—**OLD FASHIONED BICYCLE**, of the type in use in 1874.
- 6—**CRADLE** used in Oregon 50 years ago.
- 7—**OX YOKE**. Made in Ohio in 1842, and brought across the plains on the neck of two cows. Owned by Joel Perkins, a pioneer of Yamhill county.
- 8—**SMALL SPINNING WHEEL** made in Norway. Very old.
- 9—**LADIES' SIDE SADDLE**, made in Yamhill county in 1847 by Nathan Eaton, a pioneer of 1843, for Mrs. John Phillips, a pioneer of 1845, who used it for 50 years.
- 10—**BLOCK OF MAINE SPRUCE**. This was taken from a sill of the first frame house erected in Portland and was shipped from Maine via Cape Horn to Oregon in 1847 by Captain Nathaniel Crosby.
- 11—**SADDLE BAGS**, made in Wayne county, Indiana, for John H. Hunt, who brought them across the plains in 1847, who settled in Waldo Hills, Marion county. He used them constantly until 1876.
- 12—**STONE IMAGE**. Made by Indians a great while ago, hundreds of years without doubt. Washed out of the northern bank of Sauvie's Island, a few miles below Portland, on the farm of Martin Gillham, a pioneer of 1844, and found by him.
- 13—**STONE IMAGE**. Found on Sauvie's Island. Was washed out of the bank as indicated above.
