

STURGIS, PAINTER OF NUDE, FUGITIVE

leaves Note Saying He Will Drown Himself in Sea; Bond Forfeited.

(Dated From Leased Wire.) Tacoma, Wash., Aug. 11.—Efforts are being made today to locate Henri F. Sturgis, an artist, who has disappeared after mailing a letter to a friend here, declaring his intention to drown himself in the bay. Sturgis was to have appeared in the police court yesterday to answer a charge of painting pictures from nude female models. A jury had been secured to decide whether the paintings were works of art and therefore not objectionable, or whether they were merely obscenities. The envelope of the far-well letter is postmarked Seattle. In it the missing man declares he prefers death to taking a chance of conviction in court. Sturgis' bond of \$100 was forfeited. The suicide theory, however, is not given much credence. Sturgis had in his possession a remarkable fine sapphire and some small diamonds which he said were family heirlooms. These stones, valued at a considerable sum, were not found in his room at the Donnelly hotel, although his effects were otherwise intact. It was said at the hotel yesterday that a two week bill

was owing. Sturgis was last seen standing upon the sidewalk outside the hotel Wednesday morning. It is thought he took an interurban train, and is now hiding in Seattle.

Ready to Show Paintings.
A large crowd of curious persons filled the police court at the hour designated for Sturgis' trial, and several oil paintings in the nude were in court also as exhibits.

Sturgis emphatically denied accusations of "white slavery" in his methods of procuring models for his nude pictures.

His bondman obtained a bench warrant for Sturgis' arrest, saying that in furnishing the bond for the artist's release he was prompted solely by a spirit of sympathy after hearing the prisoner's description of his conditions at the city jail.

In the event that Sturgis is found his bond would not be restored, although he would have to stand trial. Sturgis is badly crippled in both legs.

CLUB TO EXPLORE CHELAN GLACIERS IS PROPOSED

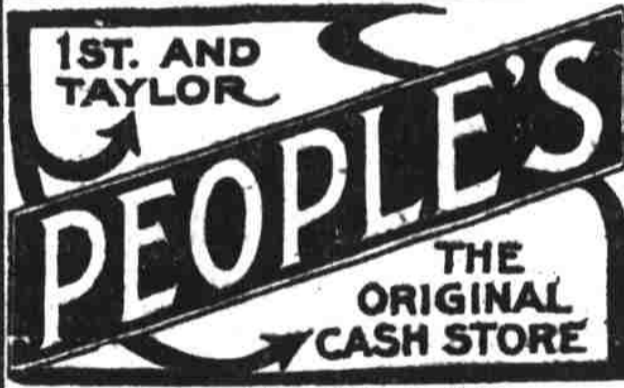
