An amendment to the liquor code providing for an increase in the annual Mcense charge for sertail liquir dealers, will be submitted to the city cour at its next meeting, the fiquer libense committee yesterday ordering the or-dinance drafted. Councilman Daly made a motion that the license be revoked. He was sec-onded by Councilman Clyde. The reordinance was indefinitely postponed, finally.

Tony Arnaud and Henry Gallet have gone out of business and they promise to quit the liquor traffic in Portland. Their successors assured the committee that henceforth the police will have no trouble regulating the old dives.

The committee postponed consideration of an application by Frank Minto to transfer his license to a man named Hartsel. Minto's place has always been run as a combination house.

B. A. Barret, proprietor of the Richelieu saloon, protested against his permit being taken away, so contemplated by Councilman Magnites.


