McNamaras Closely Guarded Are Taken to Hall of Records in Los Angeles; Younger Man to Be Tried First.

On the night of Getaber 1, 1818, an explosion turned the Lon Angeles Times building into an inform of twisted steel and flame. Ink was southered for half a block, windows in buildings across the sirest were shat-lared by the concussion. Inside of a minute the entire building was a seething mass of fizmes. Caught like rais, the employes fought blindly to get out, dome succeeded, fi died, light a dosen fell one by one through-an ones place in the floor and an open place in the floor and their bidies were burned to a orten. Others plunged blindly through the rearing flames and through open windows to death on the sidewall below. Others clung to the window sills, shrisking for the life nets, until the flames burned their fingers to the bone and they went plunging to death, while hundreds of speciators ground and watched the doomed mes. They were powerless to help.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Hall of Records, Los Angeles, Oct. 11. -Two men, one of the ordinary type, the second tall, heavy set and with a determined gleam in his bright eyes, and his every attitude that of the vet-eran fighter, left the county jail here shortly after \$ e'clock this morning. Handouffed to deputy sheriffs, as they emerged on the street other deputies. uniformed city police and private detectives practically surrounded them. The latter were plainly ready for business, indicating by their determined attitude that they would welcome rather than avoid attempts either at rescue or assault on the men under their charge. But they had nothing to do, the crowd gathered in the vicinity being drawn there by well developed bumps of real

American curiosity.

To Face Murder Charge.

The pair in chains were John J. Me-Namara, high labor official, and domi-nant figure in the councils of the Iron Workers of America, and his brother, James B. McNamara. They were en route to face a charge of murder. According to the state of California,

as represented in the person of Captain John D. Fredericks, district attorney of Los Angeles county, they were guilty of one of the most heinous crimes in the history of the United States. John J. McNamara Fredericks claimed, and he backed his assertion by

the word of a private detective, William J. Burns, was a terrorist who worked from within the ranks of organ-ised labor. McNamara, so the Burns-tale goes, had been personally respon-sible for the dynamiting of scores of buildings, bridges, viaducts, etc., con-structed under the "open shop" plan by the National Erectors' association during the past few years. In his posi-tion as secretary treasurer of the inter-national union, the detective alleged, John J. McNamara financed the opera-tions of a band of daring dynamiters, furnished them with the explosives and directed their activities. He sent his brother, James B. McNamara, to this city and destroyed the Times building, and it was for this alleged crime that the pair were about to answer, Both Men Cheerful.


