

COMMONER AVERS TAFT "PACKED" U. S. SUPREME COURT

Bryan Charges That Highest Tribunal Was Arranged by President to Redeem Repub- lican Campaign Pledges.

London, Oct. 12.—Charges that
the United States supreme court has
been packed in order to redeem the
public pledges are voiced today by
William J. Bryan in an editorial in his
publication, the Commoner. Bryan
says:

"In the 1892 platform, the Repub-
lican party promised to amend the
election law. During the campaign
Governor Hughes interpreted the promise
to mean that the 'rule of reason'
must be adopted. Later President Taft
appointed Hughes and other men of
his own rank of thought to the federal
supreme court.

"George Furman, former partner of
J. F. Morgan, recently delivered a
speech complaining that the Repub-
lican congress had not tried to re-
deem the campaign promise. That the
promise has been redeemed by the
rule of reason was applied.

"Here we have it. Hughes put
forward in support of the Republican
party. The trustee was assured that the
rule of reason would be adopted. Congress
refused, so Hughes was put upon the
supreme bench, where he helped to
amend the law in accordance with the
Republican promise.

"New President Taft, in whose
favor the promise was made, says that
the law, as amended, must not be dis-
turbed. Here is a chain of circumstan-
tial evidence sufficient to convict in a
criminal court. Yet some Democratic
leaders are willing to allow this gi-
gantic conspiracy to be carried out.

"Ask your Republican neighbor who
thinks of the supreme court being
packed with the view of having it re-
deem the Republican party's campaign
pledges."
