

1500 WORKER FOLK LUNCH WITH TAFT

President Occupies Seat of Honor at Unique Function in Milwaukee.

(United Press Special Wire.) Milwaukee, Oct. 27.—Following lunch for the occasion, 1500 workers, men and women workers and their employers sat at a luncheon here today in great President Taft, who occupied the seat of honor at the unique function. A number of the Socialist officials of the city government were present while August Vogel, representing the manufacturing interests, presided.

After the luncheon the president and his party visited a dozen city schools. President Taft will arrive in Chicago tonight, where he will meet five members of his cabinet. During his three-day stop there a number of important conferences will be held.

Taft Party Enroll as Homeowners.
(United Press Special Wire.) Green Bay, Wis., Oct. 27.—White President Taft was in Rapid City, S. D., yesterday the entire party from Private Secretary Hillis down, enrolled as homeowners. The cost of enrollment was 25 cents and even the porters took advantage of the opportunity. No one drew a homestead.

The president's train will arrive at Milwaukee tonight, stopping at Green Bay, Appleton, Oshkosh and Fond du Lac. Senator Stephens and an Governor Board boarded the train here and the president made a brief speech.

WRIGHT'S NEW DEVICE MAKES FLYING EASY

(United Press Special Wire.) Hittysmark, N. C., Oct. 27.—Any ordinary man soon will be able to fly safely, according to Orville Wright, today following sensational experiments with his automatic control device for aeroplanes. Wright gave one of the most marvelous exhibitions in aviation ever seen, according to a height of 75 feet in a glide, and holding his biplane there, perfectly motionless, for several minutes, while vicious gusts of wind buffeted it on every side.

Wright said the new appliance soon would be in general use, removing from aviators all physical and nervous strain and eliminating the necessity for the acrobatic qualities which birdmen must now employ to balance themselves in the air.

AVIATOR DIES WHEN HIS PLANE SOMERSAULTS

(United Press Special Wire.) Rheims, France, Oct. 27.—Aviator Desparnet was instantly killed here today, by falling with his machine while engaged in army aerial tests. The machine, somersaulting, from a height of several hundred feet, turned over a number of times before landing. Desparnet's body was picked up 60 feet from the machine.

ASHLAND FRUITGROWERS PLAN LARGE WAREHOUSE

(Special to The Journal.) Ashland, Oct. 27.—The directors of the Ashland Fruit & Produce Association are planning the erection of a more commodious warehouse, the location of the association having far outgrown the present facilities. The old warehouse is located on railroad ground and is subject to removal on 30 days' notice, according to the lease. With the prospective improvement in the railroad district the association faces the risk of being evicted out during the long season when it would be impossible to obtain notice to provide suitable quarters. Accordingly, the directors have called a meeting of stockholders to discuss the matter and it is expected a certain number of members will find the association housed in new quarters. It is proposed to have airtight storage rooms, a packing room and all necessary conveniences. An arrangement is partially completed with the
