

# ROSEBURG RAISES EMBARGO AGAINST STRIKEBREAKERS

### Merchants Who Have Steadily Refused Them Supplies, Hear Threats to Move Division; Alarmed, Yield to S. P.

Roseburg, Ore., Oct. 21.—Merchants here have raised an embargo against the striking shipmen of the city which has heretofore restrained the shipments from getting goods and wages to the Southern Pacific for the strikebreakers housed within the stockade surrounding the riverbank and machine shops.

Heading the request of the striking shipmen, the merchants have refused to sell even so much as a cut of chewing tobacco to the strikebreakers or to the railroad for the use of strikebreakers. They would probably have continued to do so in order to protect their interests with union men had not this threatening rumor presented itself. Being unable to buy provisions in this city, the company was compelled to go to other towns, and at the same time would be bringing more money into the town and clearing away menacing antagonism.
