

JUDGE TAZWELL TAKES A SLAP AT JOHN B. COFFEY

Denies Accusations That He is Demoralizing Police Department - Alleges a Clique Would Rule.

From the municipal court bench this morning Judge Tazwell denied the accusations made against him by Police Commissioner John B. Coffey...

Called It Fabrication. "All of this is absolute fabrication. Every case brought before me is presented on its merits unless there is no presumption. I am disposed at all times to aid the police in their efforts to rid the city of vice and demoralization...

In the matter of not doing my duty, as charged, unless I happen to want to do it unless personal friends among the police court lawyers are employed for the defense, that is another willful falsehood."

Judge Tazwell then went into detail in his explanation of what he believed was collusion between the police commissioner and keeper of resorts which enabled the resorts to run free from police molestation.

Will Not Be Swayed. "The lines I laid down when I assumed my present office, a year ago, will be followed out. They are to do only my duty and to pass on each individual case as its merits demand."
