

# NOT CRADLE HAND BUT KITCHEN RULES

## Cook Form Characteristic of Nation, We Say; Not the Rocker of the Baby.

Chicago, Nov. 2.—The characteristics of the nation are formed in the kitchen.

That was the declaration of Miss E. Woodhead of New York, official chef of the International Bazaar's association, in an address at the seventh convention of the organization in the Hotel Sherman.

By this remarking, it is said, she meant to say that the American people are not a nation of slaves, but a nation of cooks.

And by the same reasoning America's well known extravagance may be blamed on the cook.

And, in fact, every other characteristic of the race may be followed back to the kitchen.

**Should Study Kitchen.**

"If the stewards of America were to study the greatness of the kitchen we would develop our civilization with a single generation," said Mr. Woodhead.

The speaker did not say what kind of food should be developed.

He was one of several at the afternoon session of the convention who discussed the work of Dr. Wiley, head of the national pure food bureau, in endeavoring to force the use of pure foods in American pantries.

Upon the suggestion of the speaker J. J. Richards of San Francisco offered a resolution that the entire association endorse the national food expert. A telegram to that effect was sent to President Taft.

The European residences and the legation. In case the worst comes to the worst, it has been arranged that all Europeans shall take refuge in the legation building, which is situated in the east of the legation quarter and in such a position that it can easily be defended from any mob attack.

Peking, Nov. 2.—Grave reports in the imperial army today threw Peking into a new panic. News was received by the government that the cavalry and artillery battalions at Tai Wan and Shantung had revolted and captured the arsenal at Tientsin.

In Yunnan province the imperial troops have practically joined the revolt by issuing a declaration of independence. So far as the government has learned the rebellious troops have as yet made no junction with the republican forces, but it is believed certain that they will do so.

**Cadets Join Revolt.**

To add to the disaffection the military cadets at Pao Ting are joining the revolt in hundreds. They are reported to be taking with them to the rebel camps great quantities of arms and munitions of war and are certain, with their military training, to add greatly to the rebel strength.

The gravest fears are felt here that an uprising in Peking is imminent. Many shops are closed and many of the inhabitants are fleeing the city, dreading the possibility that the Chinese may rise and inaugurate a wholesale massacre of the Manchus.

**Manuscripts Now Feared.**

Offsetting the possibility that the Chinese may attack the Manchus in Peking is an hourly growing danger that the ruling race themselves may precipitate a massacre. The imperial order depriving the Manchus of pensions and compelling them to adopt Chinese names as a preliminary to fusing them with the Chinese has enraged the Manchus and the younger element are openly urging a slaughter.
