GLASSY PITCHING WON THE PENNANT

Beavers' Twirlers Allow Less Hits Than Any Other Pitching Staff.

Effective pitching by the Beaver twirling staff won the 1911 Pacific Coast league pennant for Portland according to figures that have been compiled.

The San Francisco pitching staff allowed less hits than any staff in the league and the percentage of hits made off the Portland eleven was .227.

The Beavers' twirlers were next in line with efficient twirling, although the percentage of hits made off the Oakland staff was much greater than that of the Portland team.

The Sacramento team batted nearly 350 against the Los Angeles twirlers, while the best they hit the Portland pitchers was for the percentage of .220.

THOMAS MURPHY 1911 SULKY WINNER

Veteran Driver Wins \$73,000 During Season and Rides 295 Miles.

Philadelphia, Nov. 7.—Thomas W. Murphy, who with nearly \$73,000 to his credit, ranks as the biggest money winning light harness driver of the season of 1911, rode 295 miles in his races, not counting the distance traveled while scoring.

At Indianapolis, behind R. T. C. Str R. Dr. Jones, Captain George Longworth R. Casade, Amherst Boy, Charlie Mitchell, Lady Isis and Twinkling Dan, he rode 28 miles, 18 of which were faster than 2:15.

At Cleveland, Murphy drove Casade, Charlie Mitchell, John, Belva, Captain George Twinkling Dan and Longworth R. Casade, 25 of the number in 2:10 or better.

At the International Breeders' meeting at Columbus, Ohio, he drove in 12 races, with R. T. C. Twinkling Dan, R. Dr. Jones, Captain George Longworth R. Casade, Amherst Boy, Charlie Mitchell, Lady Isis and Twinkling Dan, he rode 28 miles, 18 of which were faster than 2:15.
