

### FOUR HOOD RIVER HALLOWEEN CELEBRATORS HELD TO GRAND JURY FOR "GOING TOO FAR"

Hood River, Or., Nov. 11.—A Halloween party at George Cox, Albert Sherr, Charles Malvey and Lloyd Bishop last evening resulted in the young revelers, who are about 14 years of age, being held by Justice Beck to appear before the grand jury. The hearing took place Wednesday and the boys are now under bond.

The charges against them in running a wild party in a lobby wagon loaded with 15 feet telephone poles, including the poles, taking the wagon apart and scattering the poles and other parts of the vehicle over the surrounding country. There were a dozen boys in the mischief, but Cox, Sherr, Malvey and Bishop were the only ones identified. Their identification was through two smaller boys who happened along at the time the wagon was being disintegrated on their way to a Halloween party. Finding the small youngsters would "snitch" they were bound with ropes and kept in cages until the

wholesale market was accomplished. As the Oregon statistics do not make any other provision for packing this variety of merchandise, it is claimed by Deputy District Attorney Hartwig that the only recourse is to place the produce before the grand jury. The boys, with the exception of Cox, are the sons of well known Hood River valley apple growers in the Barrett district. Cox is employed by Miss Mary Lake, having been brought here by her from the boys' and girls' all society in Portland.

**Packboard Apple Boxes Proposed.**

Hood River, Or., Nov. 11.—An apple packing box that may revolutionize northwest apple shipping packages is being experimented with by the Davidson Fruit company of Hood River. The material is heavy packboard instead of

wood now in use throughout the Pacific northwest and in Colorado. The box is made of what is known as reinforced packboard and can be opened from bottom or top. It is much lighter than wood, which would make a saving in freight, and makes a much better looking package. A big saving according to retail fruit men. It is stated that it can be manufactured much more cheaply than the wooden receptacle for apples, so not so clumsy and takes up less room. The Davidson company will pack a number of these boxes with apples and send them to their sales agent in New York in a car with fruit packed in wooden boxes. If they stand the test it is likely that they will be generally adopted for shipments in the United States, but not for export, as foreign shippers demand an extra strong package for steamer and storage handling.

**STANDARD OIL TO BUILD BIG TANKS AT ABERDEEN**

Aberdeen, Wash., Nov. 11.—Work has begun on building the grounds recently acquired by the Standard Oil company at a point on the western outskirts of the city. Work is in the building of the vast between 100,000 and 200,000 in building of tanks, reservoirs and docks. The site fronts on the Chehalis river, and will give ample docking facilities. The building and equipment of the plant will make Aberdeen an independent oil station, and will provide fuel for the oil-burning vessels that come into this port. This will also make Aberdeen a distributing point for the Standard Oil company.
