

TRANSMISSISSIPPI CONGRESS OPENS IN KANSAS CITY

Many Prominent Men Attend Convention Where Many Questions of Interest to the West Are Taken Up.

(The International News Service.) Kansas City, Nov. 14.—The twenty-second annual session of the Trans-mississippi Commercial congress opened here this morning with more than 1000 of the most delegates in attendance. The session will end Friday.

The importance of the subjects to be considered and the industry array of prominent men who are to lead the discussions make this session one of the most interesting and important in the history of the congress. Champ Clark, speaker of the house of representatives, lives; Governor Frazier Harrison, former Senator Nelson W. Aldrich, Senators W. E. Borah and Robert L. Owen, Governor John Burke of North Dakota and many others are among the speakers.

Eleven Governors to Attend.

Eleven governors, more than 100 members of the United States senate and house of representatives, scores of heads of clubs and organizations throughout the west whose objects are the advancement of commercial interests and thousands of appointed delegates have signified their intention of being present.

The congress is the free forum of the west and all subjects of interest to westerners are open for discussion. Its reason of the presence of members of the national rivers and harbors commission, inland waterways improvement will receive a boost greater than it ever has had.

This is the question before the congress of most vital interest to the west and favoring it nearly every western state will be represented by a strong delegation. Currency reform, the parcel post and other questions in which there is national interest will be fought out on the floor of the congress.

Vitally Interesting to Coast.

Farming subjects are to receive greater attention at the hands of the congress than at previous meetings. By farming, the handling and marketing of crops, the shipping of the produce of the farms, road improvement and dozens of other subjects bearing upon the interests of the men who produce most of the wealth of the world, are to be discussed not only by experts from various government and state departments but by just plain farmers as well.

CALIFORNIA INSURGENTS LIKE OREGON MEASURE

(United Press Leased Wire.) San Francisco, Nov. 14.—Two initiative propositions, which are expected to do something to profit state politics, are being promoted by a group of California progressive Republicans, according to a report received by the Republican county committee here today. First is the adoption of the Oregon corrupt practices law.

The second would provide that no member of the legislature shall be eligible to any salaried position in the state, county or city government until one year after the close of the full term to which he was elected.

Smallest of Triplets Dies.

Pleasant Home, Or., Nov. 14.—The smallest girl of the Trimble triplets, who were born October 24, died Saturday evening and was buried in the cemetery here Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock. AUTO COMPANY HURTS PROSPECTIVE BUYER: IS SUED FOR \$15,500

"FOREIGN" PLAN IS NOT FAVORED

Judge Bean Remands Case in Which Railroad Company is Defendant to State Court.

That the United States courts are inclined to look with disfavor on the making of railroads and other large corporations of incorporating in states in which they do not expect to do any business was indicated by Judge Bean in the United States circuit court yesterday when he remanded to the state court for trial the suit of Baker versus the Oregon Trunk railway.

Railway corporations are frequently organized in states wherein they do not expect to operate, the purpose, it is said, being to thus make themselves "foreign corporations" in litigation arising in those states. Certain classes of suits between persons of different states may be remanded to the federal courts for trial.

It may be in operation within 10 years. Details will be brought within six days of completion. Stock A.T. 1111, Nov. 14 days. Brussels will be five days from the Berlin (Germany, Nov. 14 days; the distance from France to London, Nov. 14 days, will be reduced to five days.


