### Notes of Wednesday's Happenings

Brief Paragraphs Give Journal Readers the News of Late Yesterday Afternoon and Last Night.

#### Congressional.

After charges had been made that a powerful lobby was at work to procure the adoption of the bill, the house on Wednesday defeated a measure permitting the Hydro-Electric company, a waterpower corporation, to lay a pipeline across part of the Mono national forest reservation in California.

#### Pacific Coast.

Word is received from the board of geographical names, that the mountain peak in the Elkhorn range of the Blue mountains, a few miles west of the town of Haines, has been named "Hunt mountain," after Wilson Price Hunt, who was the first white man to enter the Bowdler valley, 100 years ago.

#### Eastern.

Charles Thompson Harvey, who planned the first elevated railroad operated in this country and who built the Sault Ste. Marie ship canal, is dead at his home in New York. He was 83 years old.

#### Political.

Oscar King Davis, head of the Washington bureau of the New York Times, will be general publicity manager and assistant to Senator Dixon in the Roosevelt headquarters at Washington.

#### Foreign.

A senator was caused at Lisbon Wednesday by the announcement that a large part of the Tenth Portuguese infantry at Braganza, on the northeastern frontier, had crossed the border with their arms and joined the royalists.
