Forecast of Republican Convention Made by Journal War. 20, Correct in Main -Revision.

Revision of the forecast of the Republican national convention published in The Journal March 20, bringing it to date, makes no great change in the fig-ures then given. The net result of various revisions is a net gain of 24 for Taft over Roosevelt as compared with the tabulation then given.

"Taft on the first ballot," therefore, a better guess than ever. The totals, including results in states where delegates have already been chosen and estimating other states on an impartial basis, give Taft 607, Roosevelt 327, La Follette 34, Cummins 10, doubtful 100. Fleven days ago the totals awarded raft 598, Roosevelt 342, La Follette 34, Cummins 16 and doubtful 88. The total number of delegates is 1078 and the number needed to nominate is 540. But Few Changes.

Conventions and primaries held since the last forecast was published show that it was remarkably near the truth as forecasts go. Taft lost a few here and gained a few there, but the final balancing gave only a small gain. Several transfers have been made from the Roosevelt to the doubtful column, it being now apparent that his strength was in some states overestimated. New York, Indiana, Colorado and Mississippi have held conventions or primaries since the last forecast. In New York Taft gained five more dele-gates than The Journal forecast had allowed him, and Roosevelt suffered a corresponding loss. In Indiana Roosevelt fared better than the forecast, and took eight of the delegates that had been listed for Taft. In Colorado Taft has secured eight delegates, where only six were allowed him, and the other six are now taken out of the Roosevelt column and put in the doubtful list. There is no change in Mississippi, where all the delegates were credited to Taft. Fraud Is Alleged.

Many of these delegates are contested, the Roosevelt men alleging fraud in New York, Indiana and Mississippi. The delegates listed in the accompanying table are the "regulars," who are entitled to their seats unless unseated by the national committee, which is now generally conceded to be controlled by

the Taft forces. The chief changes from the former forecast, other than in the states above noted, are in Connecticut, where four are credited to Taft that formerly were listed as doubtful, four subtracted from Roosevelt in Kentucky and awarded to Taft, six taken from Taft in Minnesota and placed among the doubtful, four saken from Roosevelt in New Hampshire and made doubtful, four added to Taft in Ohlo from Roosevelt, four taken from Taft in West Virginia and awarded to Roosevelt, and six taken from Cummins and added to Taft in Iowa.
