THE OREGON LAW ON ADVERTISING Any person, who in a newspaper or other periodical, in a public advertisement, or by letter or circular, knowingly makes or disseminates any statement or assertion concerning the quality or value of the price, the method of producing or manufacturing of his merchandise or professional work, or the manner of doing or conducting the same, which is untrue or calculated to mislead, shall be deemed to be in violation of the provisions of this law, and shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50, or to imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. (L. 1909, c. 104, p. 164).
