

Elks' Commission Plan Proves Success**Convention Plans Nearing Completion****DECORATIONS TO BE OF LAVISH DESIGN**

Visiting Elks to Be Entertained in Manner Never Before Enjoyed at Conventions.

The Elks' grand lodge convention, to be held at Portland next July, the 8th to 12th, inclusive, means much to the Pacific northwest in general and will do more good for the great city of Portland than any other single event has ever done since Portland became a city. The Lewis and Clark fair was the beginning of a movement which brought to our city many influential and intelligent citizens, and caused the investment of much outside capital. This great event did much to place before the world the natural resources of Oregon and did much to develop the commercial advantages of our city. And it is conceded by the commercial pioneers of this city that much credit is due the Lewis and Clark celebration for our wonderful growth and progress.

The Rose Festival that for the last several years has been doing much along the line of advertising to the world our climatic delights and many blessings, and placing the city of Portland upon the map as one of America's most beautiful cities, is entitled to commendation and support from every loyal citizen. There have been many other associations and institutions that have added their share of support to the great work of progress upon which the city of Portland is being carried along.

All of these events have transpired and have left their impress of success upon the body politic in proportion as the general public has extended the hand of good fellowship and good cheer.

New System Is Success.

The Elks' grand lodge convention will soon be here. Portland now stands upon the eve of an epoch in her history when it is well to anticipate and consider what must be done to bring about the fullest measure of success. Portland lodge of Elks has adopted a new system of handling the convention—stated after the commission form—there being 11 departments—chairman, parades, decorations, entertainment, reception, grand lodge meeting, publicity, treasury, auditing, hotels, general arrangements.

These different departments have been working in harmony and have the work well under way. The plans outlined are of the most elaborate character, and when successfully accomplished will eclipse anything ever attempted in the city of Portland or seen in the history of Elksdom.

The publicity work has been practically completed, and has been the widest and best ever given to an Elks' convention. The beautiful three-color posters, the beautiful booklet advertising Portland and the northwest, and the monthly bulletins are all issued by the commission. The special and advance edition of The Oregon Daily Journal and the folders issued by the various railroad companies have gone to all parts of the world.

In addition to this literature the Elks' journals of the United States have been sent in an excellent manner, and the general press of the nation has given much valuable space and excellent "writeups" of Portland and the many splendid features to be enjoyed during the convention.

Elaborate Decorations.

The decorations of the city will be the most elaborate ever undertaken. The Court of Honor, located on Sixth and Seventh, Stark and Yamhill streets, will be a blaze of glory at night, there being 100 pillars 21 feet high, and eight beautiful arches, all covered with over 30,000 electric lights.
