

DEDICATE ARMORY AT SALEM TODAY

Capital City Puts on Airs for Military Events of the Year.

Salem, Or. June 18.—(Daily and patriotic) decorated in flags and bunting, Salem is today showing appreciation of military events and paying homage to veterans of bygone wars. This afternoon the first armory is being dedicated with elaborate ceremony and tomorrow the state encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic will open here.

A special train from Portland arriving early this afternoon brought many officers and their wives from the Rose City. Immediately after their arrival the parade passed through the streets from the Oregon Electric depot to the new armory, where the address of welcome by Mayor LaMotte opened the program. Colonel Samuel White of Portland is scheduled to make response. Other addresses will be made by Governor West, Colonel James Jackson, U. S. A., retired, and Dr. Hall of Portland.

The dedicatory address will be made by Adjutant General W. E. Finney, followed by the dedicatory ritual services conducted by state officers of the G. A. R.

At 4 o'clock the flag will be run up over the building.
Tonight local and visiting officers will be guests of the Salem board of trade at a banquet at the Marion hotel, while the enlisted men will have a "big feed" at the armory. These features will be followed by a military ball.
