

U. S. S. OREGON SOLDIERS' HOME COME HERE

G. A. R. Asks Legislature to Warship Wanted in Portland During Elks' Convention; Plenty of Water.

Secretary McAllister of the Elks' 1912 convention, today received a letter from United States Senator Bourne, in which Mr. Bourne promised to use his best efforts to have the battleship Oregon detailed to Portland during the Elks' convention...
