

HE CHARGES LAND COMMISSIONER HAS DEALT UNFAIRLY

President of Deschutes Land Company Threatens to Carry Fight for Reservoir Site to Congress.

(Salem Bureau of The Journal.) Salem, Or., July 5.—Charging the commissioner of the general land office, Fred Dennett, with dishonesty and corruption and assailing the integrity of Governor West, J. E. Morson, president of Deschutes Land company, is making an appeal directly to the secretary of the interior in an attempt to go over the head of the department to secure an easement of the Crescent Lake reservoir site, which is being held up by a ruling of Commissioner Dennett until the department completes an investigation of the company's operations.

A copy of the appeal was received today by the secretary of the general land board accompanied by a letter in which Morson says: "I make this appeal preparatory to take the case out of the general land office, and the institution of mandamus proceedings."

Case May Go to Congress.

Morson says also that the conduct of the commissioner of the general land office will be presented to congress. He defies the commissioner by announcing that he intends to resume construction work today and that as soon as the road is completed to Crescent Lake work on the reservoir is to be started and continued all summer.

The easement has been held up by the general land office as a result of an investigation instituted following a report made to the land office by Governor West.

Morson prefaces his appeal by the recital of proceedings since the project was started and contends that the contract between the state of Oregon and his company relative to the interpretation of the contract existing between them needs no outside interpretation.

Collusion Hinted At.

"That the honorable commissioner of the general land office is a consummate when he attempts, without the solicitation of the state of Oregon the method by which this company may be defrauded of its legal rights when he says if the application is approved the company can stand on its legal rights and the desert land board will have no means of controlling said company except as secured under its contract.

"That the honorable commissioner has, he, without solicitation, suggests a means to defraud this company or deprive it of its rights under its contract shows himself to be dishonest and corrupt and the tool possibly of the autocratic, imperious, unbalanced and untruthful governor of the state of Oregon, and his act in this matter deserves (and so far as this company shall show itself able to present these facts) attention of the congress of the United States.

"That the state of Oregon so far as its contract with this company is concerned is demanding and receiving everything to which it is entitled under said contract and to give this company anything less than this is unlawful and shamefully dishonest, and if tolerated will fast hasten the time when the revolutionary flag will wave over our national buildings.
