

**THIRD PARTY MEN  
HAVE INTERESTING  
PUZZLE TO SOLVE**

Placing of Taft and Roosevelt Electors Before People Is Problem That Worries Both Factions Just Now.

What shall be done in Oregon in placing Taft and Roosevelt electors before the people for the November election continues to be a problem for both factions, but the Taft element is in much the best position.

Oregon has five electors, and five candidates were named as Republicans before the Chicago convention passed up the situation. Three of these candidates, William Hanley, E. V. Carter and McKinley Mitchell are standing for Taft, and a fourth, M. J. McMahon, while a supporter of Roosevelt at the primaries, is expected to announce that if he is elected he will vote for Taft as the regular Republican candidate for president. Mr. McMahon has made no direct announcement of his intentions, however.

Dan Kellaher is the other Republican candidate for elector, and he is president of a club that has repudiated the name "Republican." He is an enthusiastic follower of the new party, but the nearest he has come to stating who he will vote for as an elector is that "Taft has no standing in the state of Oregon." This is interpreted to mean that he considers Roosevelt, as the preference choice for president, to be entitled to his vote.

**Other Complications.**  
But there are other complications. If Kellaher tries to stay on the Republican ticket he will become the target of a fierce attack. He will be invited to resign and run on the third party ticket, and some of the third party leaders think this what he should do.

Under the Oregon law the candidates of each party for presidential elector are placed in party groups, and the law authorizes the secretary of state to place the presidential ticket of each party after the name of each group.

Under the form of ballot provided the names of the five candidates for elector, Carter, Hanley, Kellaher, McMahon and Mitchell will be printed in the order named, with the word "Republican" after each name, and after the entire group, in brackets, these words:

"For president, William H. Taft. For vice president, James S. Sherman."

Therefore, if Kellaher stays on the ticket, he will be stamped with the name "Republican," and it will appear from the ballot that he is for Taft and Sherman. Would the secretary of state be authorized to make any change in this form of ballot, for instance, by joining of the names of the Republican candidates for president and vice president, or by separating Kellaher from the group and putting "Roosevelt" after his name?

**Still Other Puzzles.**

If Kellaher should decide to stay on the Republican ticket, there is no way provided for getting him off, even though he is no longer a member of the party. But the law does provide that the name of any candidate shall be printed only once on the ballot, and as Kellaher is also a Republican nominee for the state senate, there has been some talk of the possibility of compelling him to resign either as a candidate for elector or for the senate.

But there is a dispute to this as well. By some it is contended that the restriction as to a candidate being only once on the ballot applies only to offices under the state of Oregon. The position of elector is a federal office, and if this theory governs, Kellaher can run for both jobs at the same time.

**Brings New Turn.**

Back of all this confusion is the question as to how the Taft men are to put up another man to take the place of Kellaher and complete their electoral ticket. Probably this will be done by petition, whether he stays on the ticket or quits. The third party men, on the other hand, need four new names to get with Kellaher in completing their electoral ticket.

This brings a new turn. If candidates are named by petition they will be merely independent candidates, not entitled to a party name. The independent Taft candidates could not be distinguished on the ballot from the independent Roosevelt men except by those familiar with his name and ideas. To gain a party name it appears it will be necessary to hold a "mass convention" in the same way that the Prohibition and Socialist tickets are nominated. Third party men are reluctant to do anything that would bring to mind the ill-starred "assembly" of 1910, which most of them denounced.
