Mountaineer, Son of Millionaire, Saved After Receiving Painful Injuries.

Calgary, Alberta, Aug. 6.—Selby Walker, son of Colonel James Walker, millionaire of Calgary, narrowly escaped death on a dangerous slope of Castle mountain in the heart of the Canadian Rockies Saturday when he lost his footing and fell a distance of 100 feet. Walker crashed against a boulder and was saved from being hurled to death over a 500 foot precipice.

The committee to secure a line of steamers will be named by the city council. The committee will be authorized to increase the amount of the pledge to \$25,000 each year for the three years, or one-third of the total fund, if it should be necessary.
