

OREGON SWEET PEA SOCIETY OUT FOR BIG HONORS

Lovers of Flower Plan to Compete in National and International Shows to Be Held Next Year.

So unusual was the exhibit of sweet peas in Portland at recent exhibits that the Oregon Sweet Pea Society will compete in a strong assurance of success in the national and international shows to be held next year.

That the exhibits may be of the widest possible range and quality the officers of the Oregon Sweet Pea Society have issued two requests that as many as possible join the society in order to be eligible for competition and that ground be prepared for planting now, according to the society's directions. The officers of the society are O. M. Plummer, president; Ralph B. Routledge, executive secretary; Mrs. Harriet C. Hindee, recording secretary. The directions for planting read:

Fall Planting Urged.

"Fall planting. If you want some very early flowers, plant sweet pea seeds this fall any time from September 15 to November 15. Select a well drained, sunny location and plant the seed about two inches deep. The success of fall planting is to get the vines up a few inches before the cold freezing weather comes. Sweet pea vines are very hardy and will stand considerable cold weather, but it is advisable to cover with loose straw or fir boughs during the few days or weeks of severely cold weather we get in December or January."

In order to be eligible for both national and international competition in sweet pea exhibits next year the Oregon society has officially enrolled as a member both of the national organizations with headquarters at Boston and the European society with headquarters in London. Delegates will be sent from Oregon to the conventions and exhibitions of both organizations.

Classifications Announced.

Preparing to make the Oregon sweet pea exhibit surpass anything of preceding years the prize committee of the society has already prepared the list of awards to be made at the show in Portland late next spring, the classification being as follows:

Commercial growers, section A—This class includes florists, gardeners and any grower who raises flowers to sell at retail or wholesale.

Private gardeners, section B—This class includes all professional gardeners who sell their services as well as the amateurs who employ them regularly. This excludes section A.

Amateurs, section C—This class is for amateurs who do not employ professional help regularly and those who actually do their own gardening.

Juveniles and school children, section D—This class is for boys and girls under 16 years of age. Flowers not grown from their own planting and care must not be shown.

Prizes.

Commercial growers, section A: Class A-1—Best general exhibit in vases (without foliage). First and second.

Class A-2—Best table decoration, other than sweet pea foliage allowed. First and second.

Class A-3—Best basket of sweet peas, other foliage allowed. First and second.

Class A-4—Best floral piece, either wire design or set piece. First and second.

Private gardeners, section B: Class B-1—Best 12 vases Spencers.

Class B-2—Best six vases Spencers.

Class B-3—Best four vases Spencers.

Class B-4—Best vase orange or salmon Spencers.

Class B-5—Best vase any color of a 1912 novelty.

Amateurs, section C, Spencer and Grandiflora types: Class C-1—Best eight vases.

Class C-2—Best six vases.

Class C-3—Best vase.

Class C-4—Best vase White Spencers.

Class C-5—Best vase Lavender Spencers.

Class C-6—Best vase Salmon or Orange Spencers.

Class C-7—Best vase crimson or scarlet Spencers.

Class C-8—Best vase primrose or yellow Spencers.

Class C-9—Best vase light pink Spencers.

Class C-10—Best vase dark pink Spencers.

Class C-11—Best vase striped or mottled Spencers.

Class C-12—Best basket of sweet peas.

Class C-13—Best vase or center piece for table decoration. First and second.

Juveniles and school children, section D: Class D-1—Best individual display of not less than 12 vases (12 varieties) of 10 or more stems each. First and second.

Class D-2—Best six vases.

Class D-3—Best vase, white.

Class D-4—Best vase, blue.

Class D-5—Best vase, pink.

Class D-6—Best vase, primrose or yellow.

Class D-7—Best vase, lavender.

Class D-8—Best vase, blue.

Class D-9—Best vase mixed colors of not less than 50 stems, sweet peas or other foliage allowed. First and second.

LABOR CONVENTION AT SAN DIEGO ADJOURNS

San Diego, Cal., Oct. 12.—The thirteenth annual convention of the State Federation of Labor was closed today, after an attempt of the minority to reduce the majority of the big San Francisco unions in the federation's affairs had been defeated. The basic came on constitution, which sought to have future conventions made up of not more than five delegates from any one union, and to establish the rule of one-delegate-one-vote. In place of the existing system, which allows the delegates to vote the strength of their respective unions.

Full endorsement was voted for the Harriman shopmen's strike, and an appeal for funds approved. The American Federation of Labor was petitioned to restore its charter to the Alameda County Central Labor council, pending a settlement of the dispute with the Electrical Workers' International union.
