Woes of Patrons on Route 1 Waterloo, Or., Described by a Sufferer.

(Special to The Journal.) Sweet Home, Or., Nov. 21.—Patrons of R. F. D. No. 1 from Waterloo, Or., say they are receiving very poor service. Waterloo is the second of a string of towns which are served by a stage line from Lebanon, which itself is at the end of a branch road running from Al-

bany and another from Woodburn.
The towns, in order, are Sodaville,
Waterioo, Sweet Homs, Foster and Cascadia, one stage leaving Lebanon each
morning, and another starting from Cascadia, which arrives at Lebanon about 3 o'clock p. m. The mail schedules cause the carrier

for H. F. D. No I. Waterloo, to leave that office about an hour before the arrival of the daily mail from Lebanon on his 25 mile drive to carry to nearly 500 persons living on his route, mail which had arrived in Lebanon one day, which had arrived in Lebason one day, had lain over there until the next morning, then had been carried by stage to Waterloo, and lain there another day and might before he could start out with it. Thus all news is two—and if Sunday intervenes, three—days old before the farmer gets it. The farmer reads the quotations in his Journal and rushes a load of produce to Lebason and ships it to Portland expecting a big check in return, only to learn in his next day's Journal that a sudden slut had caused Journal that a sudden glut had caused that particular article to drop away down, and he has thereby lost many

down, and he has thereby lost many dollars that quicker mail service might have saved him!

The farmer also may get an important letter, already two days old, which must have an immediate reply. His answer, mailed next morning, gets to Waterloo about an hour after the stage has gone to Lebanon and must lie over until the next afternoon, when it is postmarked and sent to Lebanon to wait another hour for the train. Then another wait of several hours ensues in Albany for of several hours ensues in Albany for the Portland train. As the principal business of that Lebanon train is to meet the main line train at Albany for Portland, it is argued that the schedule of the outbound stage and train might both be changed enough to enable mail to go directly through from the farmer's mailbox to Portland the same day. This would be even greater benefit now that the parcels post law permits sending by mail for many necessary supplies.

The rural carrier, A. L. Ziezing, has carried the mail since the route was started six and a half years ago, and has never let the patrons miss their mail a single day in that time.
