

PINE MANUFACTURERS DISCUSS TRADE ISSUES

Questions of general interest to the lumber trade are being discussed this afternoon at a joint meeting of the Western Pine Manufacturers' association and the West Coast Lumber Manufacturers' association. It is being held in the Multnomah hotel, where the first session was opened yesterday afternoon. This morning lumber salesmen of the Pacific northwest held a meeting in the same rooms.

Yesterday afternoon the lumber manufacturers discussed the advisability of mill operation on night shifts. A delegation from western Washington talked for the day run only, basing their arguments largely on the assertion that accidents to employees occur mostly during the night shifts, while very few occur during the day shift.

Aside from this the aggregate output of the mills would be materially reduced if none of them operated double shifts and this, it is pointed out, would have a tendency to strengthen the markets and improve conditions in general.

Wooden blocks for street pavements came in for considerable discussion and it was said by men who have studied

the subject closely that this class of pavement is steadily gaining popularity. Among those who extolled the merits of the wooden blocks was O. F. Cross, of the forest department of the University of Washington, F. C. Young of this city and C. E. Patten of Astoria.

Yesterday morning the Western Pine Manufacturers' association held its regular quarterly meeting. Last night the members of the two associations attended a banquet at the Portland Commercial club. There were no speeches.
