Glenn F. Gault, 19 Years Old Gives Himself Up to Policeman and Feels Better After Relating Story.

After keeping a secret the fact that he killed his step-father, Dan M. Leitzel, two years and a half ago, Glenn F. Gault, 19 years of age, gave himself up to Patrolman Converse at Sixth and Everett streets last night. The killing occurred seven miles southeast of Scotts Mills, in Clackamas county, about June, 1910, on a farm in the hills where he and his step-father were working.
