

**"SOCRATES' CUP,  
CHRIST'S CROSS,  
ARE OUR IDEALS"**

**Ettor and Giovanitti Make Impassioned Pleas to Jury in Lawrence Strike Case—Invite Death Sentence.**

(United Press Special Wire.)  
Court House, Salem, Mass., Nov. 23.—In eloquent, impassioned pleas, in which they openly boasted that they would welcome the opportunity to give up their lives as sacrifices to the cause for which they declared they long had been fighting, Joseph Ettor and Antonio Giovanitti, accused of the murder of a fellow striker during the recent Lawrence mill strike riots, this afternoon openly defied the jury to condemn them.

Never in the history of the commonwealth had a more dramatic scene been witnessed in a court of justice. Ettor, the fiery, impulsive, spoke first, declaring that he was ready for any fate the 12 men might mete out to him, and, as he poured out his plea, Giovanitti whispered that he "makes it for both," and afterward he also addressed the jury.

"I'll pay the penalty, do not worry about that," cried Ettor. "If you believe that I had any desire or motive to cause the death of Annie Lopizzo I ask for no mercy, no extenuation from you. If I be guilty, I want to pay the full price.

**Says He Is Ready to Die.**  
"If 12 men, chosen from among prominent citizens, believe that I am guilty of murder, I say to you that I will stand before you, erect, and take the full penalty—and my comrade has just whispered to me, 'Say it for both of us.'"

"I believe in the death chair. If we go there it will be like chess on our lips, and we will take the flag we are carrying—labor's flag—with us. I make no threat, but hundreds of working people will take it up when it falls from our hands and will carry it on, until it waves over the fortunes in Lawrence when I come. The shame does not fall on Massachusetts; the capitalists alone have reduced the human beings they control to mere appendages of machinery. Knowing this condition I came to give my services."

"I branded the finding of dynamite as a 'plant,' and in time I believe it will be shown that the death of Annie Lopizzo was a 'plant.' I fully believe that Annie Lopizzo, my sister, the sister of Giovanitti, the sister of Caruso, and of thousands of strikers, was murdered by a plot of the mill agents."

**Giovanitti Stirs Hearers.**  
Giovanitti, usually the dreamy-eyed poet, sitting so quietly, fairly swept the courtroom off its feet with his opening declaration that District Attorney Atwell was "too commercially inclined to comprehend the higher ideals."

"Maybe we are fanatics, Mr. District Attorney," cried Giovanitti. "Like Socrates, we prefer to drink the fatal hemlock; like Christ, we prefer the cross rather than to give up those ideals."

Giovanitti predicted that neither Atwell nor the jury could "dam the mighty tide of the coming revolution." He charged that any violence in Lawrence was "not caused by either himself or Ettor, but was the fault of the wage system, which, he termed 'the system by which one man controls another; owns his tools, his house, makes him as much of a slave as were the negroes in the last century.'"

**90 PER CENT OF GIFTS  
USED IN MISSION WORK**

Ninety cents of every dollar used in mission work reaches the field, instead of 10 cents, according to a statement made by Lola E. Millard, secretary of the Woman's Board of Missions for the Pacific.

The statement was called forth by a report that a delegate to the recent convention of the Oregon Federation of Women's Clubs here, had said that only 10 cents of every dollar ever reached the field.

"There is probably no larger benevolent organization in existence than the transaction of business more economically," said Secretary Millard. "Reference to the yearly reports of any of the missionary boards will show this and for this reason we could not allow the statement to go unchallenged."

**CAPT. BLOWERS WILL BE  
BURIED IN HOOD RIVER**

Hood River, Or., Nov. 23.—Captain A. S. Blowers, who died suddenly in Portland, Friday evening, was one of the pioneer merchants of the city of Hood River. He came to Hood River in the early 80's with his family, from Minnesota and engaged in the general mercantile business, which he continued for several years. Mr. Blowers was a prominent member of the G. A. R. and Masonic orders and influential in local politics while a resident of the city. He was one of the principal stockholders in the First National bank and the Home Telephone company of this city. He leaves, besides a widow, three grown sons and five married daughters. The funeral services will be held in Hood River, where the family have a family burying ground.
