When the late legislature agreed to finance the Columbia Southern Irriga-

tion company for the benefit of the settlers suffering from the deflection of the project and to insure the development of valuable lands, a little group of people who had waited long and yearningly for just such a victory and had lived sparingly while waiting, at once began to rejoice. The climax of their jubilation is a call for a "jubilation meeting" at Laidlaw next Saturday. A large number of Portland people who aided the campaign for the appropria-

tion, which amounts to about \$400,000, have been invited and a number of them plan to attend. A free basket dinner will be served and speakers from different parts of the state are to make addresses. A leader in the jollification will be J. N. B. Gerking, whose appeal before the irrigation congress, recently held in Portland, is said to have turned the tide of sentiment in favor of rescuing the project from its apparent failure.
