

PACKS ON BACKS FOOL DRUGGIST

When He Sells Whiskey to 2
"Laborers" Raid on His
Supplies Follows.

McMinnville, Or., April 16. — Following the raid of his drug store, J. D. Belt was brought here from McMinnville, and his trial will be Saturday morning. Belt, who is a druggist, is accused of violating the local option law. Detectives had been working on the case for some time, and last Saturday, when they raided the store, they dressed like workmen, rolled their blankets on their backs and hit for Willamina. They were cold and went into the drug store and purchased a quart of whiskey, each taking a drink and saving the bottle and the remainder of the contents for the police. The men, who they were prior to letting them have the liquor, and they replied that they were cutting wood nearby.

Sheriff Henderson got out a search warrant, on the advice of the detectives, who are working for the State Anti-Saloon league, and early Tuesday morning the drug store was raided and a big quantity of liquor was captured and brought to McMinnville. In the consignment there are two barrels of whiskey, one and one half cases of bottles of whiskey and a few cases of beer.

Two years ago in September Belt was placed on trial for violation of the local option law and was cleared by a jury. He was represented by his son, who made a powerful plea before the jury, and the jury returned a verdict that he was being persecuted by certain persons.
